

**Safety Council Rebate Program
External Training Credit Guide**

Ohio

Employers can earn up to *two* rebate program credits through attendance at *select* BWC safety training courses or in-person safety training from other external sources.

Employers should be encouraged to submit certificates as they are earned.

External training content

For training to qualify for rebate credit, content must be similar to topics which are otherwise presented at safety council monthly meetings.

Appropriate content includes traditional occupational safety and health, risk management, workers' compensation, and health and wellness topics. Business related safety-focused topics including environmental, social and behavioral workplace issues, and Total Worker Health are also appropriate.

BWC safety training

BWC offers a variety of courses addressing industrial safety and hygiene, safety management, construction safety, ergonomics, and risk management.

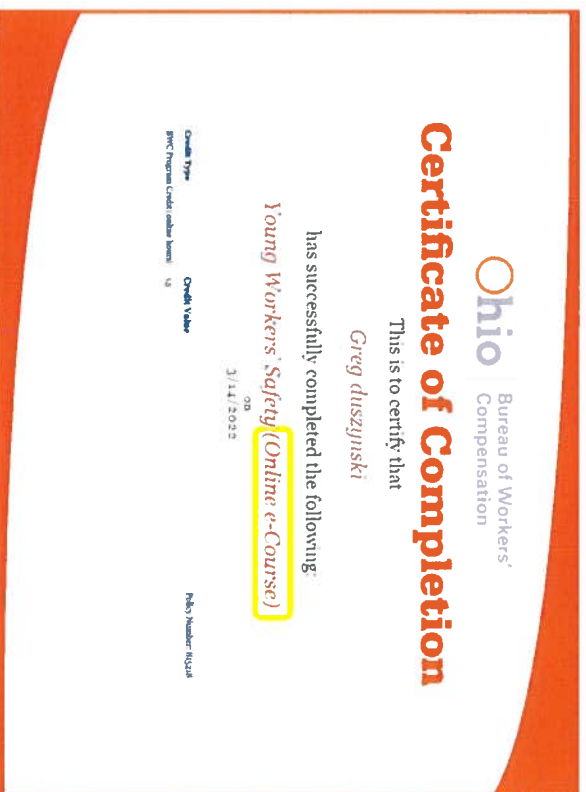

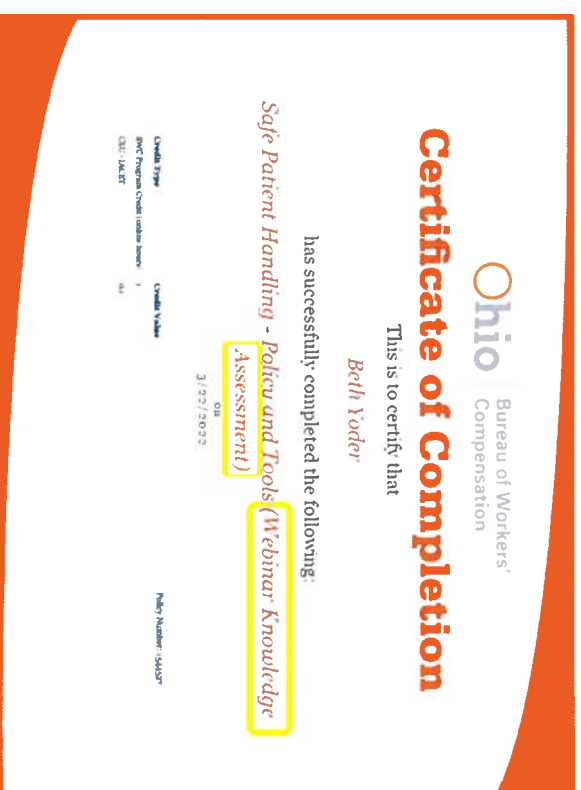


Two types of BWC training DO NOT QUALIFY for external training credit

Training from other sources

Other qualified *in-person* sources of training may include conferences, seminars or workshops hosted by:

- industry-specific associations
- authorized training organizations
- third-party administrators (TPA)
- managed care organizations (MCO)
- safety equipment manufacturers
- certified first aid, CPR, AED instructors

Exclusions

The following training does not qualify for rebate program external training credit:

- safety training conducted at an employer's own workplace
- virtual/online webinars and training
(except BWC virtual training classes)

It is the employer's responsibility to submit an official certificate of attendance to their safety council sponsor by June 30.

Upon receipt of the certificate:

- 1. Sponsor reviews to confirm the following:**
 - training occurred in the fiscal year (July-June)
 - topic is a safety council appropriate subject
 - training was in-person and not online
- 2. Sponsor submits the certificate to BWC for review via the Safety Council Portal.**
