






Training from other sources

- authorized training organizations
- third-party administrators (TPA)
- managed care organizations (MCO)
- safety equipment manufacturers
- certified first aid, CPR, AED instructors



program external training credit: The following training does not qualify for rebate

- safety training conducted at an employer's own workplace
- virtual/online webinars and training (except BWC virtual training classes)

Submitting certificate for credit


council sponsor by June 30. official certificate of attendance to their safety It is the employer's responsibility to submit an

Upon receipt of the certificate:

- 1. Sponsor reviews to confirm the following:
- training occurred in the fiscal year (July-June)
- topic is a safety council appropriate subject
- training was in-person and not online
- Sponsor submits the certificate to BWC for review via the Safety Council Portal.




